ANNOUNCEMENT

The 11th International Congress of Internal Medicine will take place on July 4-6, 2021

Larissa, Greece - May, 2020

The Organizing Committee of the 11th International Congress of Internal Medicine, in response to the critical events taking place around the world, has recognized that everyday life will not have returned to normal by July 5-7, 2020, the updated date of the Congress. It has concluded that a successful scientific meeting cannot take place on those dates. Therefore, it has decided to move the date of the 11th International Congress of Internal Medicine to exactly a year later.

The 11th International Congress of Internal Medicine will take place on Sunday to Tuesday on **July 4-6, 2021**.

Everything else remains the same: The hosting city (the venue will be announced soon), the exact same scientific program, faculty, and all institutions and organizations involved.
